What is unique about the IB, compared to regular Norwegian Videregående school?

- All courses are taught in English
- It is a 2-year programme, meaning you only have exams at the end of vg3
- You choose (almost) all subjects
- You are graded on a scale from 0-7 in each subject, and can get up to 45 points overall
- There are exams performed in every subject at the end of the year
- Only the end of year exams (and the Internal Assessment, a short document showing your academic progress) count for the grade. This means you have a full 2 years to prepare before you are graded.
- There are smaller classes, leading to more interaction between student and teacher

Students will also be taught the three core subjects, CAS, TOK and EE. What do these abbreviations mean?

.TOK

TOK stands for **Theory of Knowledge**. It is a subject in which students will learn about the concept of knowledge and how to evaluate and assess the knowledge they gain, both in academics and daily life.

.CAS

CAS is a subject in which students much perform activities that either correspond to **Creativity, Activity or Service**. These must be logged. The subject causes you to try out new things, and evolve as a person.

.EE

The **extended essay** is an approx. 4000 word essay to be handed in during the second year. It is written about a subject and topic of choice
