Further information:

The Group 1 subject is the language you are most fluent in (for many if not most students, that is Norwegian A). You can substitute a Group 2 language with an additional language from Group 1. So if you do Norwegian A and English A, you do not have to choose from Group 2. A large number of students choose this combination. IB students are not required to take a fremmedspråk (Spanish B, French B, German B). Almost all students choose Maths Applications and Interpretation.
