### **SECTION C Subject choices**

All IB students are required to take **six subjects**. The same 6 subjects are studied over vg2 and vg3. Here is how to go about choosing:

#### Step 1:

Choose 1 subject from each of Groups 1 to 5.

#### Step 2:

plus a sixth subject from groups 2 to 4.

#### **Further information:**

The Group 1 subject is the language you are most fluent in (for many if not most students, that is Norwegian A).

You can substitute a Group 2 language with an additional language from Group 1. So if you do Norwegian A and English A, you do not have to choose from Group 2. A large number of students choose this combination. IB students are not required to take a fremmedspråk (Spanish B, French B, German B). Almost all students choose Maths Applications and Interpretation.

Once you start IB you are free to change any subject choices you make here during the first few weeks of vg2 IB!

Most subjects on the list are guaranteed, however some fremmedspråk subjects in Groups 2 may not be offered.
