- Two year programme, international curriculum
- Language of instruction: English
- vg2 and vg3
- Admission: First year of Norwegian Upper Secondary School or equivalent international school
- Certification for university admission



- Do you like English?

- Same curriculum as Norwegian vg1
- Natural science, Social science and Geography in English
- Alternative when you apply in VIGO (Studiespesialisering med forberedende International Baccalaureate)
- Can choose IB or Studiespesialisering in vg2

Studies in language and literature:

- Norwegian A Literature SL/HL
- English A Language and literature SL/HL

Language acquisition:

- Norwegian B HL, English B HL

Have to choose two languages, either two from Studies in language and literature or one from each.



- Economics SL/HL
- History SL/HL
- Psychology SL

Have to choose one, can choose two. Economics and Psychology are taught at the same time in the timetable



- Biology SL (biologi 1)
- Chemistry SL (kjemi 1)/HL (kjemi 1+kjemi 2)
- Physics SL (fysikk 1)/HL (fysikk 1+fysikk 2)

Have to choose one, can choose two. Biology and Physics are taught at the same time in the timetable



- Mathematics AA (Analysis and approaches)
SL/HL (R1+R2)
- Mathematics AI (Applications and interpretations) SL (S1+S2/R1)

Have to choose one math-course



- Choose 6 subjects in two different levels, either 3 HL (higher level) and 3 SL (standard level) or 4 HL and 2 SL
- SL: average 3 hours per week in 2 years
- HL: average 5 hours per week in 2 years



- Grades from 1 to 7 (7 best grade)
- Exam in all subjects after two years
- Internally assessed work in each subject
- Grade in Theory of knowledge A-E
- Grade in Extended essay A-E
- Max points 45 (6x7 + 3)



- Minimum 24 points will give you IB diploma
- Norwegian diploma: 20 poeng and no grade below 3
- Well known for foreign universities
- Students well prepared for higher education
- Calculating Norwegian grades

- Application for pre-IB: only in Vigo
- Application for IB Diploma programme:
 - You have to apply through Vigo
 - In addition to that, you need to fill in an application directly to the school.

Deadline 1 March for all applications. You also need to send in a letter of recommendation from one of your teachers for IB Diploma programme (not for pre-IB).

Fee for IB: 6000 NOK per year
